

Gasoline-generated wind cannon



Overview

The vortex ring gun is an experimental non-lethal weapon for crowd control that uses high-energy vortex rings of gas to knock down people or spray them with marking ink or other chemicals. The Wind Cannon (Windkanone) or Whirlwind Cannon (Wirbelwind Kanone) was an unsuccessful anti-aircraft cannon developed in Nazi Germany during World War II. [2][3] It was one of Adolf Hitler 's wonder weapons and aimed to utilise powerful blasts of air to disrupt enemy aircraft. It was a strange device consisted of a large angled barrel like a bent arm resting in an immense cradle like some. Like the Vortex Gun, the Wind Cannon was also developed by a factory in Stuttgart during the war. With the actual device, tornadoes were obtained up to a height of only 300 meters, which is not enough for the effective destruction of an aircraft, as it can fly much higher.

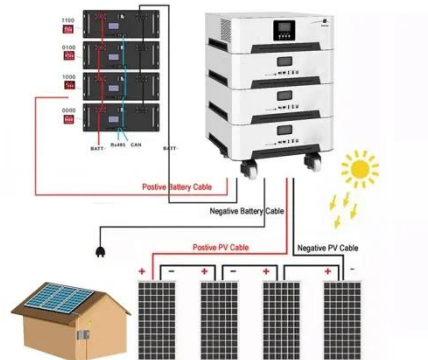
