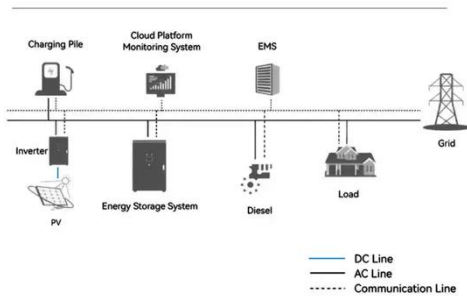
Who Invented Solar Panels?
