Overview

Somalia did not import energy. Energy sources, particularly fossil fuels, are often transformed into more useful or practical forms before being used. It represents all the energy required to supply end users in the country. Somalia has higher tariffs than neighboring countries Kenya and Ethiopia, ranging from 50-125 cents/kWh compared to 0. Somalia's energy sector. Somalia, situated in the Horn of Africa, relies heavily on imports due to its limited domestic industrial capacity and agricultural output. Today, about 80% of urban households and only around 24% of rural communities have access to electricity, according to World Bank. Consequently, the power supply systems are associated with huge inefficiencies at both the generation and distribution levels and contribute to emissions of greenhouse gases (GHG).

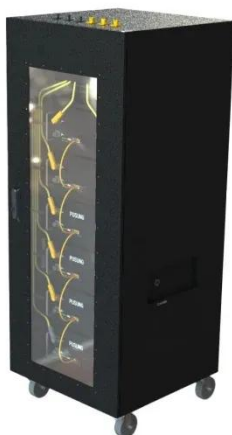

Somalia's energy needs are primarily met through imports, as the country does not produce sufficient petroleum. Crude oil and refined petroleum products are vital for transportation, power generation, and industrial activity. In 2022, Somalia's petroleum imports were valued at \$1.2 billion. Coal and Gas Products

Alongside crude oil, Somalia also imports coal and natural gas to meet its energy demands, though these imports are relatively smaller compared to petroleum.
