

Photovoltaic panels removed in Northeast China



Overview

Solar panel installations in China slowed again in August to hit the lowest in nearly three years, as producers turned to overseas markets amid sluggish domestic demand. China has officially begun withdrawing its subsidies to solar panel exporters, signaling a significant shift in global solar economics. With the removal of key incentives, including a 13% VAT rebate, panel prices are projected to rise by at least 9% in the coming months — and potentially by up to. Beijing's decision to eliminate solar export VAT rebates tackles deep structural problems: massive oversupply, unsustainable pricing, and growing trade tensions. China broke records for new solar installations in 2024 with installed capacity up 45% from the previous year and has almost 887GW of installed solar power, according to. China announced on Friday that it will change export tax rebates for a range of products, including photovoltaic and battery products. 36 gigawatts of solar capacity was added last month, down a third from 11.
